Dear Club Secretary,

I am writing to forward two documents to you. Wirral Metro would ask that you display these on your club notice boards so that all your members can be informed of the existence and objectives of Wirral Metro. You will be aware that the eight clubs on the Wirral created Metro to ensure a pathway for our more gifted swimmers to attain the highest levels in our sport. The two documents comprise firstly an overall view by Martyn Robinson, chief coach, of the ethos and organisation of Wirral Metro's high level squad and competition programme. The second document is the review of Metro's swim scheme by Fred Kirby, the coaching co-ordinator for the World Class Programme of British Swimming.

We have carefully reviewed our communication policy with yourselves the local clubs and this correspondence is the start of what is hopefully an improving, ongoing and helpful exchange. The next stage of this process is proposed to be a meeting, probably in February, to discuss and expand on our relationship. I would be grateful to receive any ideas, topics or areas of support you would wish discussed at this meeting. We are aware from ongoing discussions that some clubs wish further definition of our entry standards and we are working on this detail currently. The meeting will be open to your committee members and coaches and again I would be happy to receive suggestions as the most appropriate time or day.

Thank you for your support so far with our progression of swimming on the Wirral, hopefully by working ever closer we can ensure that more young people participate in our sport and that any who do are assured of a route to achieve their full potential.
